- Host an office "Open House" invite students & families to your office for goodies and share information on services
- Professional Learning Day coordinate an opportunity for School Social Workers in your district to earn CEUs
- Parent Information night pick a topic and have SSWers present for parents
- Host an evening event celebrating students and families (i.e. Cultural Fair, Student Talent Show, Community Service event, Library Story Night with the SSWer as the Storyteller, etc.)

- Are the link between home, school, and community in providing services to students, families, and school personnel
- · Promote and support students' academic and social success

# Activities

- Visit Governor's office and/or State Representatives to deliver advocacy messages
- Attend District Board Meeting and take photos
- Set up a table at the District Board Meeting and share brochures, resources, and highlight work done by the district's School Social Workers
- Write a letter to local newspaper about School Social Work
- Develop a PSA about what School Social Workers do
- Invite a local journalist or high school journalism student to shadow you for part of your nonclinical day and write an article about School Social Work
